

The Trip

We are planning a leisurely 2 day drive to Reno, two days in Reno and then drive back.

- Wednesday Departing mid-morning, we will take I-5 to Hwy 99 up to Fresno, then cut inland
 to spend the evening in historic gold country. We have rooms reserved in Sonora, CA. Patty
 has found a cute little café/knickknack shop for lunch along the way. We should arrive in
 Sonora in time to visit the usual tourist traps, including wine tasting.
- Thursday We are planning a short little drive to Columbia State Park for breakfast. If you have never been, it is a fun stop. It is the west coast's answer to Williamsburg, Va. Like Williamsburg, docents at Columbia dress in period costumes and perform tasks straight from the gold rush, such as blacksmithing, carpentry and gold mining. From there, we have an optional stop in wine country and a leisurely drive along Hwy 49 through gold country and on up Hwy 89 around Lake Tahoe and on to Reno.
- Friday We will have time to visit the local sites. Patty and I will be leading a caravan around
 the lake and hosting a party at our house in Incline Village, NV. We have a great party house
 with a view of the lake. We hope all of you can make it we could handle the entire club so
 there is no reason not to come. Friday night, we will head back to Reno for the big events,
 including Sock Hops, TV celebrity signings, and of course, cruising.
- Saturday This is the big car show day. While the show goes all week, the number of cars and visitors peak on Saturday. Saturday night will be a big party, with announcements of show winners.
- Sunday Return to the grind. We are suggesting a group departure for a drive down US-395 through Owen's Valley. The route is full of beauty: following the Walker River, grand vistas of Mono Lake, Mammoth Mountain, volcanic fields of Owens Valley and the Mojave Desert. We are planning several stops. We have lunch planned at Jack's Waffles in Bishop. This is a family business that has been around for over 60 years. The atmosphere is great as is the food. If you want to make the return trip a two day drive, this is a great place to overnight. For a one day drive, this route takes about 9 hours. It is about 75 miles shorter than taking I-5. We plan to arrive home in early evening.
