

I have already heard back from several members who want to attend the Dec 12 SCCA-SDR rally (Avocados, Vines & County Lines). That's fantastic. We are going to go live this weekend with registration on http://www.MotorsportReg.com I will send a link to everyone for the rally as soon as it is available.

Some help:

If you don't already subscribe to motorsportreg.com go here early and get a free account: https://www.motorsportreg.com/index.cfm/event/public.signup Get the standard plan. Like I said, it's free and there is all kinds of other automotive events stuff on there too. You will have to do it to register anyway.

Our rally's are all SCCA sanctioned events. Therefor, you need a SCCA membership to participate. You have two choices. You can go ahead and get an annual membership for \$95, or you can get a weekend membership for \$15. Only the driver needs to pay or be a member. Most SCCA events are like this and offer weekend memberships, but it can add up. The annual membership also covers sanctioned autocross, racing and rally events held anywhere in the country. You can become a member at scca.com and follow the links. You also get a nifty monthly magazine. In my opinion it's much more worthwhile than NCCC for about the same price, but I digress.

If you choose to only pay for the weekend membership, you will do that on the registration pages at motorsportreg.com, not the SCCA site. In addition to the \$15 if you are not a permanent SCCA member, the cost for the rally is \$25 per car (member or not). Again, there is no charge for the navigator but you do have to have a navigator registered before you can complete the registration process, and you MUST have a navigator. In fact, the way it's set up right now, the navigator has to be registered first.

I'm trying to get that changed but it may not happen before the weekend. The registration process walks you through it though.

Another motivating factor for participating: We are going to make this a charity event. We are still looking into the best way to do that but we would really like to get some Toy's for Tots involvement from the marines at the starting point, where everyone can bring a toy.
